### विजट महाराज मंदिर, लूजहाँ (खाददार) : एक सांस्कृतिक और आध्यात्मिक विरासत

चौपाल की हरी-भरी वादियों में स्थित लूजहाँ गाँव का विजट महाराज मंदिर न केवल धार्मिक आस्था का केंद्र है, बल्कि यह क्षेत्र की सांस्कृतिक, ऐतिहासिक और लोक परंपराओं का जीवंत प्रतीक भी है। यह मंदिर खाददार क्षेत्र में स्थित है, और मान्यता है कि यहाँ स्थापित राज की मूर्ति सरहाँ से विशेष विधि द्वारा लाई गई थी, जहाँ वह न्याय का प्रतीक मानी जाती थी।

मंदिर से जुड़ी लोककथा के अनुसार, मूर्ति को लाने के लिए सरहाँ मन्दिर के पुजारी अमरु सितार्क द्वारा एक विशेष पद्धति से मूर्ति चयनित की गई थी। यह घटना आज भी लोगों की स्मृति में एक न्यायप्रिय और आस्थामूलक निर्णय के रूप में अंकित है।

मंदिर की वास्तुकला पारंपरिक हिमाचली शैली की अद्भुत मिसाल है। लकड़ी और पत्थर की नक्काशी, दोहरी स्लेटों की छत, खुली पूर्व दिशा से आती सूर्य की किरणें - ये सब इसे विशेष रूप से भव्य और पूज्यनीय बनाते हैं। मंदिर में तीन मुख्य मूर्तियाँ हैं - राज की मूर्ति, अदराजी और पुजारी कुल देवता की मूर्ति।

यह मंदिर धार्मिक आयोजनों का प्रमुख स्थल है। वर्षभर में वैसाखी, हरियाली संक्रांति, कार्तिक पड़ेई, मकर संक्रांति, शिवरात्रि और भादो के चडैवली मेले जैसे उत्सव धूमधाम से मनाए जाते हैं। विशेषकर शिवरात्रि पर रात्रि जागरण, चार पहर की पूजा, और पूरे गाँव की भागीदारी इसे अत्यंत जीवंत बना देती है।

पूजा पद्धति में लोक आस्था की गहराई झलकती है। प्रातः पूजेल और सायं दियेल, साथ ही विशेष अवसरों पर देवकार्य और जागरा जैसी परंपराएँ आज भी जीवंत हैं। पूजा में ऊन की माला, फाजा, जिंदाऊल, और लोकगाथाओं का गायन (जैसे पांडव, कर्ण, नारायण कला) विशेष स्थान रखते हैं।

मंदिर के पास स्थित प्राचीन शिव सरोवर को पांडवों द्वारा स्थापित माना जाता है, जिसमें शिव के 12 ज्योतिर्लिंगों की प्रतिकृति विद्यमान है। यहाँ के बजंगी व वाद्य वादन परंपरा विशेष खानदानों द्वारा निभाई जाती है। देवता की चांदी से बनी सजावटें जैसे करडा, अंबारी, सिंहासन आदि यहाँ की कलात्मक विरासत को दर्शाती हैं।

इस धार्मिक स्थल की महत्ता सिर्फ एक पूजा स्थल तक सीमित नहीं, यह पूरे क्षेत्र की आत्मा है - आस्था, न्याय, परंपरा, और लोक-संस्कृति का संगम। विजट महाराज मंदिर चौपाल क्षेत्र की लोक अस्मिता, श्रद्धा और सामाजिक एकता का प्रतीक बनकर पीढ़ी दर पीढ़ी जीवंत बना हुआ है।
